



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Madison Opera High School Apprentice Program offers high school students the unique opportunity to explore and experience the world of professional opera. With behind-the-scenes access to rehearsals and performances, one-on-one interaction with professional artists and industry experts, and guidance on training and higher education programs, the apprentices receive a thorough introduction to the production process and careers in the performing arts. Since its inception in 2008, over seventy students from the Dane County region have participated in the High School Apprentice Program. Many former Apprentices have gone on to sing with the Madison Opera Chorus, and even in solo roles.
